

God's Five-Step Power Sin Wash

The Bible teaches that all sin temptations can be avoided and all sin- enslavements can be victoriously overcome as a member of the New Covenant of God.

God's Five-Step Power Sin Wash, is to be practiced whenever a sinful stronghold or addiction continues to enslave a member of God's New Covenant. Be encouraged to carefully learn and practice these steps. Enjoy the freedom and peace that the New Covenant from God offers.

Introduction

These five specific steps taken from 2 Timothy 2:19-26, enable a member of the New Covenant:

1. To clean themselves from sin,
2. To flee (overcome) sin-temptations,
3. To pursue right things with a pure hearted friend while avoiding arguments and quarrels,
4. To receive a Godly repentant heart that accepts knowledge of truth to regain their senses,
5. To escape (set themselves free) from the devil's sin-captivity.

Key Scripture

“In a large house there are articles not only of gold and silver, but also of wood and clay; some are for special purposes and some for common use. Those who *cleanse* themselves from the latter will be instruments for special purposes, made holy, useful to the Master and prepared to do any good work. *Flee* the evil desires of youth and *pursue righteousness, faith, love and peace, along with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart*. Don't have anything to do with foolish and stupid arguments, because you know they produce quarrels. And the Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but must be kind to everyone, able to teach, not resentful. Opponents must be gently instructed, in the hope that *God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth*, and that they will come to their senses *and escape from the trap of the devil*, who has taken them captive to do his will. (2 Timothy 2:19–26 NIV)

Real Life Application of These Five Steps

To Cleanse. *I cleanse myself each time I am convicted of a sin.* I confess and express to Almighty God my decision to stop each sin completely and receive God's forgiveness, confirmed by a witness (Matthew 18:15- 18, John 20:22-23, 1 Corinthians 6:9-11, Galatians 6:1-2, James 5:16, 1 John 1:9, Revelation 22:14)

To Flee. *To avoid each temptation outwardly, I contact my pure hearted friend to assist me evade that sin, not give into the temptation and put my mind on something good and right.*

Inwardly, by the stronger power of Holy Spirit, I resist the devil's short- temptation-suffering and receive God's strong, firm and unwavering restoration (I John 4:4, 1 Peter 5:8-11).

From repeating these steps each time I need them, the Holy Spirit completely puts to death each of my sin-strong holds and misdeeds (Romans 8:13).

To Pursue Righteous Truth. *My pure hearted friend assists me discover God's truth to replace the devils sin-deception and to stay on God's narrow road to eternal life (Matthew 7:14, James 5:19-20).* This servant-friend never quarrels, argues or resents spiritually-washing my feet repeatedly. He gently instructs me with patience, knowing full well that only God can change my heart.

Repentance. *When God gives me a repentant heart to understand His truth, my mind is renewed, I recover my good sense and see how dumb the devil's deceptive lie really is. (2 Corinthians 3:2-3, Ezekiel 36:26-27).*

Escape. *Then I escape from the devil's lie-trap by my firm decision to believe and stand on God's truth.* By continuing to repeat *God's Five-Step Power Sin Wash*, I actually do "...escape from the trap of the devil..." 2 Timothy 2:19–26 NIV

All Temptation Can Be Avoided (What A Great Way To Live!)
