

## New Testament Sin List

The following is a sin list taken from the New Testament along with a brief definition (if needed) and their corresponding passages. The point of the sin list is not condemnation or shame. The point of the sin list is to continually cycle through the list during your personal time with God and with your disciples. Use it to simply ask the Holy Spirit to point out any sin that you are not aware of, or need to come into agreement with God about and repent. How can we “avoid every kind of evil” and “throw off...the sin that so easily entangles us” if we are not aware of what the Bible defines as sin and evil? (1 Thessalonians 5:22, Hebrews 12:1)
