What does a disciple-making opportunity look like?

- Preparing yourself first repentance, being filled with the Spirit, asking for guidance/truth, listening
- Being sensitive to the Spirit during the meeting
- (Remember this is organic and not a program, these are simply suggestions that have been productive in making disciples for many years with many people.)
- · Be willing to abandon any agenda to offer God's truth for any need in their life
- Intentionally encourage them about the progress you see in their spiritual journey
- · Ask if there is any problem, worry, or questions from life that we can work through together
- Ask if they have any struggles that they want to talk about, confess, and receive forgiveness
- Confess any of your own personal struggles and teach them to pronounce Christ
- Hold them accountable to any goals that they have requested accountability
- Ask if they have any questions from their Bible study and journaling through the week
- Study a command, discuss a portion of the character traits, or review a section of the sin list
- Make a prayer of application
- Ask about any pertinent prayer requests and close with praying for and over them

- 4. Look and wait for God to grant a repentant heart divine revelation come to their senses v.25-26a
- 5. Escape and be set free from the trap of satan v.26
